Scholarship Program Guidelines

Last update: February 27, 2026

The Organizing Committee of the XIV Argentine Congress of Virology (CAV 2026) will award Registration Grants and Registration + Travel Grants to encourage the participation of young professionals in the CAV 2026 Congress.

1. General Requirements for Applications (All Categories)

Applicants must be the first author and presenter of an abstract accepted for the Congress. Everyone may be the registered lead author for only one (1) abstract, although they may appear as co-authors on others.

2. Academic Status Verification:

Applicants must prove they hold one of the following positions: graduate student (PhD, Master's, or Specialization); resident; postdoctoral fellow; assistant researcher at CONICET or equivalent.

Supporting documentation must be attached to the application form.

Scholarship applicants should not pay the registration fee until they receive the final decision regarding their application.

The application deadline is March 6, 2026.

A. REGISTRATION GRANTS

The grant will cover the full registration cost for the XIV CAV 2026.

Undergraduate students are exempt from paying the Congress registration fee; therefore, they should NOT apply for a Registration Grant.

B. REGISTRATION + TRAVEL GRANTS

A limited number of grants will be awarded, which include:

Full registration fee waiver and financial aid to cover travel expenses (either in full or in part). The specific amount will vary based on the applicant's place of residence.

Geographical distance will be prioritized for the allocation of this benefit. Therefore, in addition to the general requirements, applicants must reside more than 200 km from the City of Buenos Aires.

Grant amounts will be assigned according to the following prioritization of geographical zones:
